Burton/May Pride Award: This award, named for its founders, John Burton and Ken May, is awarded annually “to recognize outstanding lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, questioning or intersex (LGBTQI) youth who, through their participation, dedication and initiative, have helped foster a positive self-image among other LGBTQI youth.”

Applicants for the Burton/May Pride Award will be considered for all available scholarships administered by Safe Schools Desert Cities.
